## **W3 professorship for midwifery science**

The professorship is associated with the directorship of the Institute of Midwifery Science at the Center for Obstetrics and Gynecology. The candidate is responsible for the further development of the existing academic program in midwifery studies within the faculty and in close interaction with the Department of Obstetrics and Prenatal Medicine.

Requirements for employment are a degree in health or midwifery sciences or a comparable subject as well as habilitation or proof of equivalent scientific achievements. Experience in teaching in accordance with Section 36 of the North Rhine-Westphalia Higher Education Act and many years of professional experience in obstetrics are also required.
