at the Department of Philosophy at the earliest opportunity.

The primary objective of the new appointment is the development of an internationally competitive research programme in environmental ethics, with a focus on informing the applied sciences and public policy.

The successful applicant is expected to have outstanding academic achievements in environmental ethics, demonstrated by lead-authored publications in peer-reviewed journals. Interest in informing public policy guidelines and the applied or natural sciences is essential.

The professorship will be closely connected to the research at the Institute for Science and Ethics (IWE), a Central Research Unit of the University of Bonn. The overall objective of the IWE is to enhance research in the areas of environmental ethics, neuro-ethics and the ethics of artificial intelligence and robotics.

Expertise in the Institute for Science and Ethics' other research pillars – Al and robot ethics or neuro-ethics – is beneficial. The applicant is expected to independently establish research projects and new collaborations, as well as national and international networks. Experience and success in attracting third-party research funding and participation in joint research projects are prerequisites.

Apart from scientific excellence, a particular commitment to teaching students and experience in the organisation of study programmes are expected. The successful applicant should have the capacity to work in multidisciplinary and international teams. An excellent command of English is a must.
