Professorship 'Animal Nutrition' (W3)

The successful candidate is expected to be internationally recognized in the field of nutrition of farm animals whereby the research focus may be within nutritional physiology, or innovative ration design and feed science with ruminants and/or non-ruminants as target species. With the topics of land use, resource efficiency, environmental and animal welfare as well as food safety and quality, cooperation is expected with working groups of the Institute of Animal Science, the Faculty of Agriculture, the transdisciplinary research areas of the university (TRA "Innovation and Technology for Sustainable Futures" and "Life and Health") as well as national and international agricultural research institutions with regard to existing and future research networks. Moreover, the candidate should actively contribute to the research foci shaping the profile of the animal science group (<http://www.itw.uni-bonn.de>).

In terms of teaching, the professorship is involved in the Bachelor's degree programs in 'Agricultural Science' and 'Nutrition and Food Science' and in the Master's degree programs in 'Animal Science and Agricultural Science' and 'Resource Management in the Tropics and Subtropics'.

The conditions of employment are according to §36 Hochschulgesetz NRW.
